Parade Rules

Upon entry of the parade with a completed registration form on file, you are agreeing to follow the rules below. Help us to make our parade a safe and enjoyable event for all age groups.

- All Motorized Transports & Vehicles must provide their own insurance and assume full responsibility of their actions while in the parade. Be mindful of warm temperatures and have plenty of water available for all participants.
- There shall be no children under the age of 4 years old walking in the parade route without an adult present and the use of a stroller, wagon, or carrier.
- To avoid a potential safety hazard of spectators blocking the parade route, **NOTHING IS TO BE THROWN FROM ANY MOVING VEHICLE** Participants are welcome to hand out candy/promotional material but may not throw it. Any parties found throwing candy will be pulled from the parade and will not be invited to participate in next year's parade.
- All floats, trailers, and pulled carriers shall have lights that are working, secure, and safe. Children under 10 years old shall have a ratio of 6 children per 1 adult. No children are allowed to stand and or dance on a moving vessel.
- Riding on the hood of a vehicle is prohibited.
- All vehicles must be operated in a safe and reasonable manner. Operators are expected to have full control of their vehicles at all times. Failure to do so will result in immediate removal from the parade.
- Any animal entered in the parade must be in control at all times by a responsible party. Any animal waste left in the parade route will be cleaned up immediately by a designee that the entrant provides. If they are not walking with the unit, the animals will not participate.
- Between Reed Dr and Pat's Pizza will be the "Quiet Zone" this year. In this area, we ask that you keep noise levels low
