

PUBLIC NOTICE
TOWN OF LINCOLN PUBLIC MEETING

This notice is to inform the public that the Town of Lincoln has received funding from the Environmental Protection Administration (EPA) Brownfield Grant to perform cleanup activities for the Lagoon located in Parcel 2 (Site #1) and the Powerhouse Building #23 Parcel 3A East (Site #2) of the former Lincoln Pulp & Tissue facility at 50 Katahdin Avenue. Site #1 grant is being used to address the sludge and wastewater associated with the wastewater treatment lagoon, asbestos abatement of the Vehicle Maintenance building, and waste removal throughout Parcel 2. Site #2 grant is being used to mitigate asbestos, PCB impacted building material, waste, and design and implement a cover system for a black substance impacted with the compound benzo(a)pyrene that partially coats the basement. A copy of the Draft Analysis of Brownfield Cleanup Alternatives (ABCA'S) are currently available for public review at the Lincoln Town Office located at 29 Main Street and on the Town's website (<https://www.lincolnmaine.org>). The Town of Lincoln will be receiving public comments on these documents and the ongoing remediation efforts until Monday June 15, 2026 at 3:00 p.m. Comments can be submitted in writing to Ruth Birtz, Economic Development Administrator for the Town of Lincoln via email at ruth.birtz@lincolnmaine.org.
